Time is an essential but elusive object for everybody. Philosophers and astrophysicists have all tried to define it. For us, psychoanalysts, it takes part in the logic of speech and participates in the dynamics of desire. In this seminar we will try to show that it is a presentation of the logical object that Lacan located at the center of the Borromean knot. We will deduce from this the importance of the present time in analytic treatment, and notably of the analyst's presence for the handling of the transference. Finally, we will attempt to describe the different positions of the subject in relation to time according to the clinical types.
